#### Work Order Notice

To our tenants... During this time of county lockdown due to COVID-19, the EHA and maintenance team are working on how to best balance tenant and worker health and safety with maintaining work that needs to be done on units. In an effort to reduce the spread of COVID-19, maintenance continues to respond to work orders that compromise health and safety in each unit and surrounding areas. When responding to emergency work orders, maintenance team members will wear masks and gloves and will keep as much distance as possible from tenants; we may ask tenants to be out of the unit, go into other rooms, and/or wear masks while work is being done. Maintenance will make note of non-emergency/ non-urgent work orders and will get to them as soon as safely possible in accordance with our agency COVID-19 policy and county COVID-19 regulations. Thank you for your patience during this time and please feel free to call regarding all work orders or any questions or concerns

In addition, please only use the emergency maintenance phone number for emergencies. Examples: Hot water heater erupted, toilet is clogged, you smell gas, etc.

# COVID-19 Emergency Guidelines

- 1. WEAR A MASK IN PUBLIC. Wash it frequently.

**EXCITING NEWS** You will soon have the option of online payments for your rent. No more stamps and trips across town, getting money orders or forgetting.

**GOOD NEWS** EHA has added a new member to the maintenance team staff.

**VERY GOOD NEWS** A new staff position had been created and filled, Housing Advocate. Most of you already know Jennifer Boone who was formerly our caseworker. She now works with Community Liaison, Logan Keyser, in resolving tenant issues, as well as works with Section 8 landlords, neighbors, other community members, and on special projects.

**HAVE YOUR NEEDS CHANGED?** If your physical health has changed and you can no longer safely get around in your apartment, let EHA know. They can help you with safety improvements in your unit. This question is included in your annual recertification.

**RAB** had some concerns, and had our voices heard. Please share your concerns too! Also, meet your neighbor. You can help keep your neighborhood safe.

## Quick Answers to Help You

**Reminder:** Use of the dumpster next to the office is free. So cleaning up around your house or doing fall cleaning is easy. The dumpster is emptied on Friday's. If it is full, come back the next day it is open. Dumpster hours are Tuesday 8-10:30 a.m. and Thursday 1:30-3:30 p.m.

**Neighborhood Watch:** Are you interested in starting or participating in a neighborhood watch group? If so, please contact Housing Advocate Jennifer at 443-4583, x217.

Are drop boxes available? There is a drop box at the main entrance for paying rent and change forms. There is another drop box at the opposite end of the building for recertifications or large amounts of paperwork associated with housing changes.

**Trash pickup?** Tenants are responsible for trash, toys or trip and fall hazards around their unit. Please help maintain a safe environment for all.

**Cleaning tip:** Dust from the top down and dust each room, including the topsides of all furniture, undersides of shelves, handrails, picture frames, TV screens and knickknacks.
